

Part B (Project Summary)

Title: Multi-media PSHE Workshop

Goal:

Establish a Multi-media PSHE workshop that is **relevant to the new teaching and learning rationale** of striking the balance between **generic skills learning** and **values/attitudes nurturing** especially in the **Key Learning Areas of PSHE** in the Education Reforms.

Objectives:

1. Facilitate students to learn with **enquiry skills** in approaching social issues.
2. Encourage learning through active participation in a wide range of **group activities**.
3. Enhance students' capability in various **generic skills**, namely, collaboration, communication, creativity, critical thinking, problem-solving, information technology
4. Nurture various personal, social, moral and civic **values and attitudes** such as sense of responsibility, sense of commitment, respect for others, positive life values, etc.
5. Provide a good tool for different Social Science subjects/PSHE subjects, namely Principles of Account, EPA, Economics, Geography, History, Chinese History, Religious Studies, (or even including Cultural and Science subjects) to work in **collaboration to develop a multi-perspective study** on an issue of common interest.
